



Cast Your Vote!

Please remember to vote online or mail your paper ballot to Vote-Now so it is *received* by December 7th. OR, you can vote in person on December 8th, between 9:00am and noon in the Lakeside Room. If you decide to vote on the 8th, bring in the ballot you received in the US Mail or we will provide you a new one.

If your home is in a trust . . . Be aware, unlike the UPCA election where there's one vote per household, the UPRD Charter specifies that each resident and/or owner gets a vote in the UPRD election. If your home is in a trust, trustees as owners get to vote, not the trust itself. Unfortunately ballots were improperly sent to trusts; any such improper ballots will not be counted in the election. In some cases this meant other person(s) on the trust did not receive a ballot. An adult resident, who is not on the deed, is also eligible to vote and may not have received a ballot. If either is true in your household, please email the District Manager at carvalhov@pfm.com with the subject line "Need UPRD Ballot." Please include the person's name, email address and the address of your residence. We will verify eligibility and email a ballot right away.

If you are a proxy-holder, you must bring the signed proxy forms (or a good copy of the proxy) with you on December 8th (9am - noon). Volunteers will verify each proxy

and ask you to complete a Proxy Vote Form. Separately, you can cast your personal vote at the same time.
