



IF YOU RECEIVED THIS EMAIL, you are on the Electronic Communications list for the University Park Recreation District and, *if you are an eligible voter* (see below), you are automatically signed up to vote electronically in the upcoming election of the UPRD Board of Supervisors. Or, you will have the option to vote by paper ballot or by proxy. You must choose *one* of your options:

TO VOTE ELECTRONICALLY

By mid-November, you will receive an email from Vote-Now, the independent company whom the UPRD has contracted to assist with this election.

- That email – with a subject line UPRD BALLOT - will include an e-ballot you can simply fill out and submit electronically.
 - Please add the Vote-Now e-address elections@vote-now.com to your contact/approved senders list so their email does not go into spam! (A reminder email will be sent to those who have not voted. After the election, you will NOT receive any further emails from Vote-Now, promise!)

TO VOTE BY PAPER BALLOT

That same week a paper ballot will be mailed from the UPRD by the US Postal Service to your University Park address. If you choose to vote on a paper ballot,

- Fill out the paper ballot and return it in the enclosed postage paid return envelope to Vote-Now.
- Or, drop your paper ballot on December 8, from 9am to noon, in a secure ballot box in the Lakeside Room at UPCC.

TO VOTE BY PROXY

- Either print the proxy form you receive by email or use the form sent by US mail; sign it; then send or give it to the person whom you are asking to vote for you.
- Your Proxy-Holder (must be an eligible voter) needs your signed, hard-copy proxy form to vote for you the morning of December 8, from 9am to noon.

YOU'RE AN ELIGIBLE VOTER IF YOU . . .

- Are a Resident who lives at your UP address for 182+ days a year and are over 18 years old.

OR

- Are a Homeowner whose name is on the deed of property where no Resident (defined above), lives, unless that Resident has sent you a proxy.
