



UPRD Board of Supervisors' Election Results

Today was the official Election Day leading to the selection of two candidates to serve four-year terms on the Recreation District Board of Supervisors.

The final tally of votes was completed by the election volunteer group early this evening and here is a listing of the candidates and vote count totals:

David Murphy	708 votes
Rusty Piersons	544 votes
Jory Berkwits	433 votes
Carol Shabe	284 votes
Bill DiPaolo	278 votes

Write-in votes: Jim Case 3 votes; and 1 vote each for Toi Estes, Walter Shepherd, Rich Timme, Pat Thompson.

As the top two vote recipients, **David Murphy and Rusty Piersons are elected RD Board Supervisors for four-year terms.**

The success of the election process was the result of the commitment of a talented, hard working team of volunteers: Election Chair John Bondur, Jim Corrigan, Todd Emmerson, Marc Loundy, Dale Otterman, Marcia and Greg Selep, Pat Singletary, and a boost of election day energy from Kathy Bondur, Joyce Giberti, and Jay Hyde. Special recognition must be given to an extraordinary group of Club staff members – Dawne Waite, Dana Cutalo, and Rico Alcalá; the RD District management team led by Vivian Carvalho; and District Counsel Mark Barnebey.

It is important to note that 1,239 individual voter ballots were submitted, with just 3% disallowed for document irregularities. The final ballot count of 1,201 represents approximately 50% of the RD voter population.
