## **Resolution 2020-12, Election of The Board of Supervisors**

**RESOLUTION 2020-12**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE UNIVERSITY PARK RECREATION DISTRICT SETTING A 2020 ELECTION DATE FOR THE ELECTION OF SUPERVISORS AND PROVIDING SPECIFICITY REGARDING SUPERVISOR LENGTH OF TERMS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE..**

**WHEREAS**, the University Park Recreation District (hereinafter the “District”) is a recreational district created by Manatee County Ordinance 18-29 (the “Charter”), pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 418, Florida Statutes; and

**WHEREAS**, the District is empowered under the Charter and Chapter 418, Florida Statutes to operate and manage the Country Club and other District property for the benefit of its residents, and in furtherance thereof to exercise the rights and privileges under the laws of the State of Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, the District is authorized, pursuant to the Charter and Section 418.21, Florida Statutes, to elect a five-member Board of Supervisors (the “Board”) selected among the residents of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the Charter and Section 418.21, Florida Statutes, residents of the District have the right to vote in the election of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 2-8-153(d) of the Charter, the Board has the ability to modify the term lengths of each Supervisor to staggered terms with three seats being filled in an even-numbered year and two seats being filled in the next even-numbered year.

**WHEREAS**, on June 14, 2019, the Board adopted resolution 2019-30, to extend the length of terms to the 2020 election.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE UNIVERSITY PARK RECREATION DISTRICT:**

1. The 2020 elections of supervisors shall be held on December 8, 2020.
2. The candidates receiving the first highest, second highest, and third highest number of votes shall be assigned to seats 1, 2, and 3, respectfully. These Supervisors will serve on the Board for a term of 4 years. The candidates receiving the fourth and fifth highest number of votes shall be assigned to

seats 4 and 5, respectfully. These Supervisors will serve on the Board for a term of 2 years.


3. This Resolution shall supersede any resolutions in conflict and become effective upon its passage.
